Crafting Your Tile(s)

When you arrive at Woodstock Elementary School, you will find raw clay tiles laid out on tables with basic designs painted on them. You will be assigned a tile to personalize by adding texture and select carving. Symmetry Tile Works will take the tiles back to their studio for drying, glazing, and firing. The finished 9'x11' mural will be installed at OHC in May of 2019.

This fall, you can take part in a special art project designed to bring people of all ages together to create a beautiful work of art. You can help make tiles, and you can contribute financially to sponsor tiles on behalf of others. You can even honor or memorialize someone special to you.

From October 24-27, 2018, noted tile artist **Robert Rossel** of Symmetry Tile Works in Epping, New Hampshire will be in residence in the art classroom at **Woodstock Elementary School**. Students will create tiles during art classes, while community members will make tiles after school and on the weekend. Once completed, all the tiles will be arranged into a mosaic for display on the brick wall at the Ottawaquechee Health Center (OHC) that faces Pleasant Street. A directory will be included indicating the name of each tile creator, the location(s) of their tile(s), and a list of those sponsoring tiles on behalf of others.
